

Report on BMF- Kenya work for April 2025

PASSOVER HOLIDAY OUTREACHES

Our major outreach activity this month happened around the Passover weekend i.e. from Friday

18th to Monday 21st around Gikambura and Kikuyu areas.

The open-air meetings took place at a public ground in

Gikambura everyday from Friday to Sunday

with an attendance of about 100 men each day.

Ten of the surrounding Chapters participated in inviting men in their areas to the meetings.

Around 100 men committed their lives to Christ through the morning hours home visits where

members visited homes around their Chapters to invite men to the outreach. These members of

Chapters divided themselves into groups of 3 to 5 men with each group visiting several homes in

their respective area.

During these home visits many family needs were prayed for with many of them feeling very encouraged.

The teams then urged those who received the Lord to attend the afternoon outreach meetings which started from 3 pm to 5:30 pm each day.

A good number of those who received Christ attended the afternoon outreach with their friends. During the three days a total of 145 men responded to the prayer of salvation in the meetings which had a total attendance of about 300.

We also prayed for several people with needs in the meetings as well.

The home visits was a special programme where Chapter members were able to interact with community members and to cement friendships.

In total 245 men accepted the Lord throughout the Passover weekend.

Report on BMF- UGANDA work for April 2025.

On 28th April, Jude Musisi and I went to Hoima Prison. We arrived there at 3pm when the inmates had returned from labour work. The O.C welcomed us and asked us to wait for 30minutes so that the inmates could first bathe. He asked the Officer on duty to gather the 568 men enrolled in that



On 29th April, Jude Musisi and I went to Kigumba Prison. We arived there at 2pm when the inmates had finished lunch. The Officer on duty welcomed us and took our permission letter to the Office of the O.C who asked her to assemble all the 354 men enrolled in that unit outside under the tree shade. Jude gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his short testimony, and then I gave my full story. 291 men received salvation, 6 of whom were Muslims, and one was a Prison Warden on guard of the assembly. Many of the inmates were suffering from flu, but we prayed for them and I believe many healing miracles happened after our prayers.



On 30th April, Jude Musisi and I went to Buliisa Prison. We arrived rthere at 8 am when the inmates were having breakfast. We waited 20 minutes for them to finish, and then the O.C. instructed the Officers on duty to gather all the men enrolled in that unit outside on the verandah of the main building of their cells. 207 men gathered. Jude gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his short testimony, and then I gave my full story, 182 men received salvation, 4 of whom were Muslims. One of those Muslims had the tittle of Hajji, because in 2017 he went to Mecca (Saudi Arabia) for pilgrimage. We gave him 3 minutes to testify how he was convicted to denounce Islam, He told us that a certain abnormal power entered into his heart and told him to accept all the words we said because they were true, and he had no power to resist. Jude opened his Bible and shared the Scriptures with the men who received salvation, and explained to Hajji that it's the Holy Spirit who convicted him.

No.of men reached since 2008 = 112,383.

No.of men received salvation since 2008 = 87,376.
