

Report on BMF- Kenya work for November 2025

BMF KENYA NOVEMBER 2025 REPORT

INTRODUCTION

Over 1,000 people were reached through the outreaches in November. The highlights of the month's outreaches were Thika Town and Makongeni areas. These meetings were set up with the assistance of Edward Mburu and other contacts in the area.


The two meetings that happened in the last weekend of November (29th and 30th) had a good response of more than 500 men in the two areas. Majority of these men work in factories in Thika, which is an industrial town.

The reception to the testimonies was very good with a combined response of more than 400 men responding to receive Christ.

The leaders of the new Thika Chapter are planning another outreach on Wednesday, December 31st

and those of the new Makongeni Chapter, on Sunday 21st.

Below is a summary report of our outreaches in November and the December planned outreaches.



NOVEMBER 2025 OUTREACHES REPORT

1. KANGIRIA OUTREACH on Thursday 13th from 5pm to 7pm.

Venue: Deliverance Church Hall.

Speakers: Samuel Njogu and John Gathecha.

Attendance: The meeting was attended by over 100 men from the surrounding area.

Salvation: 38 men responded to the call of salvation.

Remarks: The next outreach in the area was scheduled for Saturday December 6th at Kangiria Open Grounds. A committee was appointed to plan invitations since this outreach is targeting to reach over 300 men in this area that is receiving new residents, who are buying and building there, at a very high rate.

2. RUMWE CRESCENT CHAPTER OUTREACH on Sunday 16th from 11am to 5pm.

Venue: Rumwe Gardens Resort.

Speakers: Samuel Njogu and Stephen Ngugi.

Attendance: 75 family members. The men came along with their wives and some came with their children.

Salvation: 19 men responded to the call of prayer for salvation.

Remarks: The meeting, being the last in the year for the Chapter, was held

in Rumwe Gardens Resort to reflect on the Chapter progress and to plan

how to reach the Rumwe area. Leaders from Rumwe neighbourhood Chapter were invited to the meeting to get planning assistance for future outreaches in their area.

Members enjoyed goat meat from the resort and spent time together until 5 pm.

3. KIBURUTI CHAPTER OUTREACH on Sunday 16th from 4pm to 6pm.

Venue: John Ogeta's home.

Speakers: Samuel Njogu and John Ogeta.

Attendance: 22 men were in attendance.

Salvation: 3 men responded to the call for salvation.

Remarks: The Chapter members committed to reach out to the neighbours, one on one, in December and thereafter plan another outreach.

4. ONDIRI CENTRAL CHAPTER "Father and Son" outreach on Saturday 23rd from 7pm to 9pm.

Speakers: Samuel Njogu and Stephen Ngugi

Venue: Wetland School Hall.

Attendance: 120 men and their sons.

Salvation: Every one of those who were invited responded to the prayer of salvation and were prayed for - about 70 men.

Remarks: We had a great time together as men and our sons. Stephen, the first speaker, encouraged the men present to participate in reaching more families and to spend more time with their sons. He also led us with some songs using his guitar.

After several short, but uplifting testimonies, Samuel shared his testimony, prayed for salvation and then led an open talk (question and answer session), where men, and especially the sons, asked questions.

It was a very lovely moment and we plan to schedule more meetings of this nature.

5. MAIMAHIU CHAPTER OUTREACH every Wednesday from 3pm to 5pm.

Venue: Maimahiu Open Grounds.

Speakers: Simon Kiarie and Samuel Njogu.

The outreaches in Maimahiu are now weekly, i.e. every Wednesday from 3pm to 5pm in Maimahiu Town Hall.

Traders, Lorry drivers and families of needy members of the community are attending these meetings.

The Chapter has a good team of dedicated members who participate in inviting men.

BMF is supporting the very needy cases of people in the area with foodstuffs and clothing through well-wishers.

Attendance: In this month a total of 200 men participated in attending the weekly meetings.

Salvation: Over 100 men responded to the call of salvation.

6. THIKA TOWN OUTREACH on Saturday 29th from 9am to 11am.

Venue: PCEA Church Thika Hall.

Speakers: Samuel Njogu, Stephen Ngugi.

Attendance: Over 300 men attended the meeting.

Salvation: Every one of the unsaved men that came to the meeting responded to the call of salvation - about 200 men. We all felt the presence of God in this meeting.

Remarks: The next meeting is scheduled on Wednesday 31st from 5pm.

7. THIKA MAKONGENI OUTREACH on Sunday 30th from 3pm to 5pm.

Venue: PCEA Makongeni Church Hall.

Speaker: Samuel Njogu.

Attendance: The meeting had an attendance of about 200 men.

Salvation: About 100 men responded to the call of salvation.

Remarks: The next outreach meeting was scheduled for Sunday 21st from 3pm.

NOVEMBER 2025 OUTREACH SUMMARY


BMF supported the Maimahiu outreach and the ongoing school's training team.

Report on BMF- UGANDA work for December 2025.

On 28th December, Jude Musisi and I went to Pader Prison. We arrived there at 11am. The O.C welcomed us and took us to his office to sign in the visitor's book. We shared the Word of God with him in the office, and he received salvation. He assembled all the men enrolled in that unit outside in the compound. Jude gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his short testimony, and then I gave my full story. 243 men received salvation out of the 286 men enrolled in that unit. Jude started with a Christian song to minister to them and then he opened his Bible and shared Scriptures with the men who had received salvation to assure them that they have made the right decision to accept Jesus as their Saviour because He is coming back soon. We prayed for two men who had health issues. They believed in the healing power of the Lord, and they started to feel better before we left the place. I am sure God healed them completely after.

We donated five boxes of washing soap to that prison at the end.

On the 29th Decwember, Jude Musisi and I went to Kaladima Prison. We arrived there at 8:30am, when the inmates were still in the morning assembly. The OC welcomed us and he asked the men to listen to our message. He told us that for him, as a Muslim, he can't waste his time listening to our Christian stories, so he moved away. Jude gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his story, and then I gave my full testimony. 332 men received salvation out of the 354 men enrolled in that unit,11 of whom were Muslims, but they were concerned about being

harassed by the OC for turning from Islam to Christianity. We prayed for them to be protected by the Lord from that persecution. We donated five boxes of washing soap to that prison at the end.

On 30th December, Jude and I went to Patongo Prison. We arrived there at 10am when the inmates were inside the cells. The Officer on duty assembled them outside in the green compound. Jude gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his short testimony, and then I gave my full story. 293 men received salvation out of the 326 men enrolled in that unit, 8 of whom were Muslims. Jude opened his Bible and ministered to them. Two Muslims tried to make a noise in order to interrupt us, but the Prison Wardens took them back to the cells. We also prayed and God managed the situation, because He wanted the above mentioned souls not to perish. We donated five boxes of washing soap to that prison at the end.
