programme, effectively, with the aim of reaching as many high schools that are open to us, as


possible, through the Ministry of Education since 2021.

Report on BMF- UGANDA work for May 2025.

REPORT ON BMF- UGANDA WORK FOR MAY 2025.

On 18th May, Kasamba Jacob and Tumukunde Jimmy went to Lake Katwe Prison for discipleship. They taught 68 men from the book of Ephesians, Chapter 1:3-5 and Psalm 32:1-5.

On 25th May, Kasamba Jacob and Tumukunde Jimmy went to Rukooki Prison for discipleship. They ministered to to 125 men from the book of Ephesians, Chapter 1:3-5 and Psalm 32:1-5.

On 29th May, Jude Musisi and I went to Ndagwe Prison. We arrived there at midday. The O.C welcomed us and asked the Officer on duty to assemble the 361men enrolled in that unit outside

under the tree, since it was noon and the sun was very hot. The tree shade was not large enough to accommodate all of them, so some men assembled under the inext tree nea by. We stood in the middle of the two trees to ensure that both groups could hear what we were saying properly. Jude Musisi gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his short testimony, and then I gave my full story. 304 men received salvation. We donated five boxes of washing soap and four Bibles to that prison at the end.

On 30th May, Jude Musisi and I went to Kiseka Prison. We had made the programme with the O.C to reach the Station at exactly 8am, but we were delayed on the way because of the potholes in the road, and arrived at 9am. The O.C ordered the Wardens to assemble outside in the compound all the men enrolled in that unit. Jude gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his short testimony, and then I gave my full story. 293 men received salvation out the 337 men who were assembled, 6 of whom were Muslims. Jude opened his Bible and read some Scriptures to affirm the men who received Jesus in their hearts that they have made a right decision. We donated five boxes of washing soap and four Bibles to that prison at the end.

On 31st May, Jude Musisi and I went to Buwenge Prison, arriving there at 8:3am when the inmates were having porridge to go out for labour work. The Wardens on duty assembled them in the compound after they'd had breakfast, Jude Musisi gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his short testimony, and then I gave my full story. 218 men received salvation out of the 243 men enrolled in that unit. We prayed for all with health issues and other needs after, and then we donated five boxes of washing soap and four Bibles to that prison at the end.

No. of men reached in May 2025 = 941.

No. Of men received salvation in May 2025 = 815.

No. Of men reached since 2008 = 113,324.

No. of men received salvation since 2008 = 88.191.
